

Recommendations

The capacity of any organization to improve is directly related to its ability to recognize, acknowledge, and act on its strengths and limitations. Although Princeton Alternative Elementary School is guided and characterized by several strengths and accomplishments, there are challenges facing the school that are opportunities for improvement. Therefore, the Quality Assurance Team offers the following recommendations for improvement:

1. Review the mission statement annually and not only inform stakeholders but involve them in a collaborative process to review and revise the mission and belief statements.
2. Continue to update technology and incorporate computer instruction in the classroom.
3. Increase vertical communication among grade levels to insure subject area continuity.
4. Upgrade/repair the playground and purchase additional playground equipment.
5. Involve all grade levels, the librarian and the counselor on the School Improvement Team, thereby insuring that all elements of the school's program are participating.
6. Incorporate foreign language instruction and introduction to other cultures in the early grades.
